- A learning community of students and faculty from around the world who study key global issues, simultaneously and interactively.
- Partners and participants comprise an international problemsolving team, addressing case studies of utmost importance for human health and the survival of our planet.
- Fully interactive technology including live videoconferences and interactive online labs, intellectual discussions among students, faculty and international leaders.

## Why have a Global Seminar?

- Shared understandings that transcend national boundaries, cultures and backgrounds offer the best hope for a healthier and more sustainable world.
- Physicians in training will be more prepared to articulate political agendas and understand complex real-life situations.
- The greater the number of medical students training in critical thinking and dialogue, the greater their capacity to impact human health.

## The Global Seminar Goals

- Create changes in health and medical education to foster international distance learning partnerships and a forum for future development.
- Teach critical and creative thinking about key health and environmental issues and approaches.
- Use technology to create a model of virtual global education.



## The Global Seminar Objectives


- Enhance intercultural communication skills, improve learning and build leadership skills.

# The Global Seminar Method

- Case Study Approach
  - Students apply research and analytical skills to discuss and reflect on real-life cases from a variety of perspectives
- Constructivist Learning Philosophy
  - Faculty members coach and facilitate student-centered, experiential learning
- Innovative Technology
  - Interactive videoconferencing
  - Electronic discussion boards and virtual chats
  - Web-based course management and archival system







## The Global Seminar Organization


Students across global institutions share a common curriculum and come together through videoconferences to discuss cases and share reflections.

- Medical schools in Dominican Republic, Honduras and El Salvador come together in dialogue
- Each University selects a Faculty Coordinator
- Management of course activities is facilitated through email, telephone and videoconference.
- Members meet at a biannual Global Seminar Conference to plan spring semester course offering.


